

Declaration for implementation of the REACH regulation 1907/2006

As a manufacturer of electronic products according to REACH, we are back-end user. Obligations due to the production and placing of substances/chemicals for preliminary registration or rather registration do not concern us. Our products are goods and therefore not to be defined as substance or preparation, respectively. Moreover, no substance is extruded from the products in normal conditions. Consequently, we are subjected neither to compulsory registration nor to the obligation to draw up safety data sheets.

According to article 33 of the REACH regulation, the obligation to forward information concerning Substances of Very High Concern which the products could contain, exists for all companies.

This counts for products containing a concentration of Substances of Very High Concern of more than 0.1 percent by weight.

The following substances have additionally been integrated in the SVHC list:

1. Name of substance: lead
CAS number: 7439-92-1
EG number: 231-100-4

Components of our goods contain lead alloys (brass).

Items of copper and copper alloys are no substances or preparations and are not subject to labelling or classification obligations. Also, the drafting of a safety data sheet is not necessary.

2. Name of substance: Potassium perfluorbutane sulphonate
CAS number: 29420-49-3


Components of our products contain this substance as flame retardant.

We point out that the recipe has not been changed and that the properties of the product did not change.
